Selecting Service Requests Bug

A recent Windows 11 upgrade has affected Prelog functions. Users will encounter a message stating "0 selected" when selecting service request(s) for items of evidence. The statement can be disregarded. Clicking the OK button will allow the system to still accept the service for you to continue with your prelog submission. Screenshots 1-4 demonstrates how to work around the bug.

To remove an existing service request, click inside the field to the left of the yellow question mark, and use the backspace key to remove the request. Select a different service after clicking the yellow question mark and proceed as described above. When you click Continue, a notification will appear that the previous request will be deleted. Click the Delete button and continue with your submission. Figure 5 shows the notification when removing and replacing a service request.





Screenshot 1 - Click the yellow question mark.




Screenshot 2 - Click desired request, then right arrow button.
