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SLED GUIDANCE ON HOW TO APPLY FOR ELECTRONIC MONITORING CERTIFICATION

In accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 17-15-37(A), the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) has developed standards for the use and approval of active electronic monitoring devices, and a process to certify electronic monitoring agencies. The initial version of the **SLED STANDARDS FOR ELECTRONIC MONITORING AGENCIES AND ELECTRONIC MONITORING DEVICES (Standards)** was issued on November 1, 2023.

For all entities seeking certification as approved electronic monitoring agency in South Carolina, please submit the below-listed items to:

1. Completed **SLED APPLICATION**. (Available on SLED's website www.sled.sc.gov).
2. **2 sets of fingerprints** from each applicant (if the applicant is an individual); or each partner, director, and officer of the applicant, if the applicant is a corporation, partnership, limited liability company, or other entity.
3. **Proof of a general liability insurance policy with at least one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) of coverage.**
4. **All required certifications, documentation, and acknowledgments required in the Standards.**
5. **A current list of all employees and 2 sets of fingerprints for each.**
6. **A copy of all written policies and procedures required by the Standards.**
7. **A list of all monitoring devices that the applicant intends to use and all items required by the Standards when requesting certification of a device.**
