SLED CHARGES EDGEFIELD COUNTY MAN WITH ACCESSORY AFTER THE FACT TO MURDER

The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) charged Anthony Lee Fletcher, 58, with Accessory After the Fact to Murder on Wednesday, April 3, 2024.

Details can be found in the attached warrant.

Fletcher was booked at the Edgefield County Detention Center.

SLED previously charged Roscoe Pough, Jr., 37, with Accessory After the Fact to Murder on Monday, March 4, 2024, and Quenell Marquis Anderson, 37, with Murder on Wednesday, March 20, 2024. SLED was requested on March 2, 2024, by the Johnston Police Department to investigate a death. The deceased was later identified by the Edgefield County Coroner as Ricky Martin, Jr., 35, of Sumter, SC.

The case will be prosecuted by the 11th Circuit Solicitor's Office.

The defendant Fletcher took possession of the firearm Anderson used to shoot Martin. After Martin's shooting, Fletcher was observed getting into Roscoe Pough's 2002 Chevrolet Avalanche (SC License Plate) and leaving the scene with Pough and Anderson. This shooting occurred in the outside common area of May Street, Johnston, South Carolina same being in the County of Edgefield County South Carolina.

Personally appeared before me, the affiant Kegan A. Kelley who being duly sworn deposes and says that defendant Anthony Lee Fletcher did within this county and state on or about March 2, 2024 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

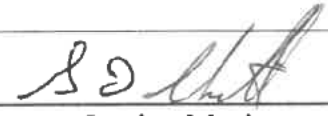
Accessory after the Fact to Felony A, B, C or murder

I further state that there is probable cause to believe the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On March 2, 2024, the defendant, Anthony Lee Fletcher, while within Edgefield County, South Carolina, did knowingly, and willfully assist the co-defendant/suspect, Quenell Marquis Anderson, being that after the fact of the murder of Ricky Martin the defendant took possession of the firearm Anderson used to shoot Martin. This shooting occurred in the outside common area of [REDACTED] May Street, Johnston, SC. After Martin's shooting, Fletcher was observed getting into a Roscoe Pough's 2002 Chevrolet Avalanche (SC License Plate [REDACTED]) and leaving the scene with Pough and Anderson. Probable cause is based on interviews, and a review of cellular telephone information where Anderson stated the defendant, Fletcher, was in possession of the firearm used in the shooting of Martin. This being in violation of Section 16-1-55 of the South Carolina Code of Laws. This case is being investigation by agents of the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division.
